The "In Search of Truth" program began in August 2011 and is now being heard every Saturday at 1:45 p.m. The shortwave station is Southwest Broadcasting on 9435 kHz. Potential audience is 2.5 billion, broadcast from Taiwan.

I have sent 32 sermons to brother James Jones of Fairview TN who tags the messages with a closing announcement and contact information. Soon I will bundle several more sermons to send to James.

Brethren in Lawrence County TN are again responding with the necessary support to keep this program on the air. 2011 support will carry us through May of this year. We need to hear from three more congregations to take the program through May 2013. We are continuing to pray that Lawrence County churches can help again this year to keep these messages on the air.

ZIMBABWE "VOICE OF TRUTH" PROGRAM TO BEGIN IN 2012

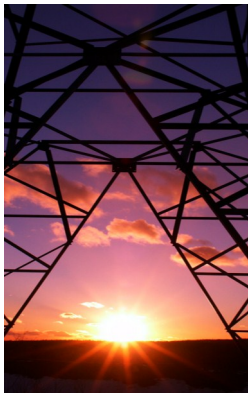
Sermons for Zimbabwe will be ready soon! Brother Roger Villines' friend, Jacob Nhenga, will have a visitor from Zimbabwe early in April. That friend will take these sermons to Zimbabwe in his suitcase when he returns April 5. Jacob sent me the names and contact information for two churches of Christ in Zimbabwe. He believes these messages will air free of charge on a couple of stations. Loy Mitchell, longtime missionary in Zimbabwe who now lives in Henderson, TN, recorded the closing announcement with the names of the contacts in the "heart-language" of the people on February 7 in the Freed-Hardeman campus radio station.

SRI LANKA "VOICE OF TRUTH" PROGRAM CONTINUES

My gospel messages began to be heard over Radio Sri Lanka in December 2010 and are continuing to be heard weekly on Wednesdays. Brother Jerry Bates, from Winona Mississippi transported 12 new sermons to Sri Lanka. He left the states on February 10. Harold and Lilani Thomas, missionaries in Sri Lanka, report that strong response and good contacts continue to result from the program. 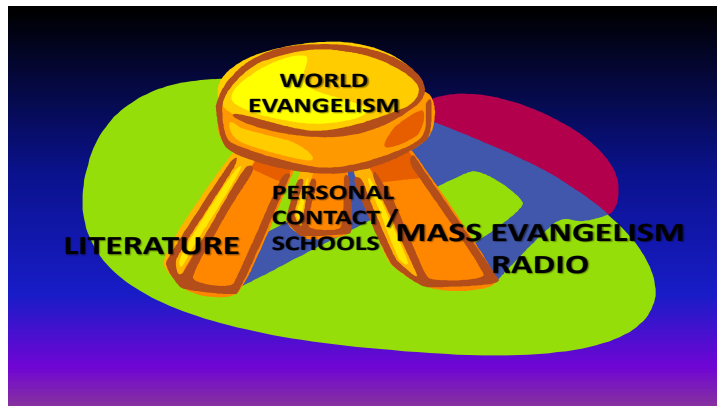
Please pray that these topics will meet with souls hungering and

Mission Work: a three-legged stool!



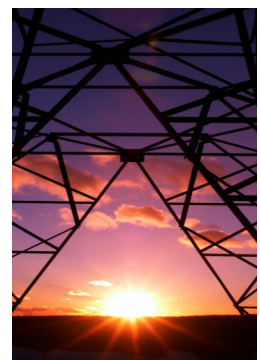
Larry and Iva Nell Murdock

WHAT BUDDHISTS BELIEVE ABOUT AN AFTERLIFE

Buddhism teaches that there is a cycle of birth, death, and **rebirth** and that the process is according to the qualities of a person's actions. This constant process of becoming ceases at the fruition of **Bodhi** (**enlightenment**) at which a being is no longer subject to causation (**karma**) but enters into a state that the **Buddha** called *amata* (deathlessness).

WHAT HINDUS BELIEVE ABOUT AN AFTERLIFE

Hindus believe in an immortal soul which is **reincarnated** after death. According to Hinduism, people repeat a process of life, death, and rebirth in a cycle called **samsara**. If they live their life well, their **karma** improves and their station in the next life will be higher, and conversely lower if they live their life poorly. Eventually after many life times of perfecting its karma, the soul is freed from the cycle and lives in perpetual bliss.

WHAT MUSLIMS BELIEVE ABOUT AN AFTERLIFE

Muslims believe that everyone will be resurrected after death. Those who believed in Islam and led an evil life will undergo correction in **Jahannam** (Hell) but once this correction is over, they are admitted to **Jannat**

(Paradise) and attain immortality. Infidels on the other hand and those who committed unforgivable evil will never leave Hell. Some individuals will therefore never taste Heaven.
