VOICE OF TRUTH

The "Voice of Truth" program broadcast from Taiwan was first called "In Search of Truth". It began in August 2011. In July 2013 the name was changed to Voice of Truth. The program is heard every Saturday at 1:45 p.m. The shortwave station is Southwest Broadcasting on 9435 kHz. We are told that there are 2.5 billion people within the sound waves of that station. The broadcast is in English so that narrows the audience to English listeners, but that is a sizeable group in that part of the world. English is the "trade language" and is understood by millions in Asia.

Thanks to the brethren in Lawrence County TN churches of Christ who are supporting this program. We are continuing to pray that Lawrence County churches can continue to help keep these messages on the air.

Brother James Jones of Fairview TN continues to forward my sermons to the station in Taiwan. Brother Reuben Emperado of the Philippines continues as the contact person for broadcast respondents.

Q/A: HOW DO YOU DEVELOP YOUR MESSAGES?

Every message is rooted in God's Word. Preachers should start with God's Word and tell people what God says, especially when what God says is so different from what people say or do. Many messages are prompted by people who are saying things contrary to God's teaching.

In every message I try to anticipate questions from the listener. I imagine myself reasoning with one person. What does the listener believe and practice that is contrary to what God says about it? This step means that I must keep learning what Muslims Hindus, and "Christian" groups say about topics that deal with salvation.

Each message starts and ends with one idea. I focus on simply one message from God. However, I deal with objections to and perversions of God's one truth. Each message is written out fully in manuscript form. These manuscripts are available on the website.

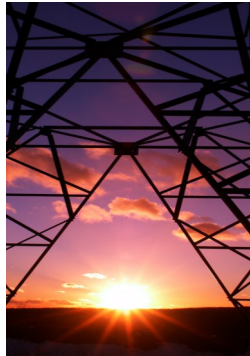
SRI LANKA "VOICE OF TRUTH" PROGRAM CONTINUES

The Sri Lanka sermons are heard on Wednesdays; the Taiwan sermons are heard on Saturdays.

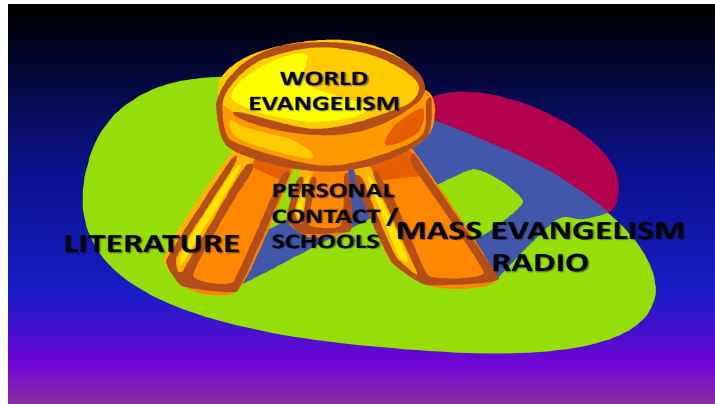
Please pray that these

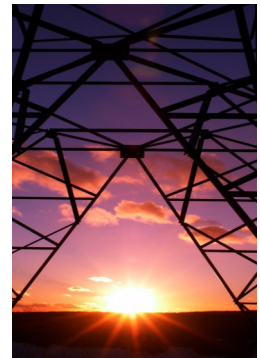
Iva Nell and Larry married in 1967 in Lawrenceburg, TN. They have used their years preaching and teaching the gospel of Jesus Christ.

WHAT BUDDHISTS BELIEVE ABOUT AN AFTERLIFE

Buddhism teaches that there is a cycle of birth, death, and **rebirth** and that the process is according to the qualities of a person's actions. This constant process of becoming ceases at the fruition of **Bodhi** (**enlightenment**) at which a being is no longer subject to causation (**karma**) but enters into a state that the **Buddha** called *amata* (deathlessness).



HINDUISM



WHAT HINDUS BELIEVE ABOUT AN AFTERLIFE

Hindus believe in an immortal soul which is **reincarnated** after death. According to Hinduism, people repeat a process of life, death, and rebirth in a cycle called **samsara**. If they live their life well, their **karma** improves and their station in the next life will be higher, and conversely lower if they live their life poorly. Eventually after many life times of perfecting its karma, the soul is freed from the cycle and lives in perpetual bliss.

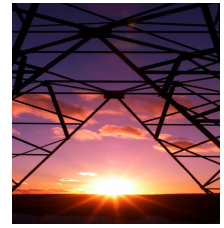
WHAT MUSLIMS BELIEVE ABOUT AN AFTERLIFE

Muslims believe that everyone will be resurrected after death. Those who believed in Islam and led an evil life will undergo correction in **Jahannam** (**Hell**) but once this correction is over, they are admitted to **Jannat**

(Paradise) and attain immortality. Infidels on the other hand and those who committed unforgivable evil will never leave Hell. Some individuals will therefore never taste Heaven.

The Voice of Truth radio program is a 15-minute message that generally moves along five steps. There is the Attention Step, the Need Step, the Satisfaction Step, the Visualization Step, and the Action Step. The Action Step is at the end of the program and contains contact information for the hearer who wants to respond to the message. The Action Step is announced by a professional radio voice.

Your mission church or missionary can be featured in the Action Step of each broadcast. Location can be promoted; advertising a telephone number of a missionary has proven highly effective. A Website can also be advertised.

Each broadcast teaches some aspect of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Preaching Christ is to preach the gospel plan of salvation. Preaching
