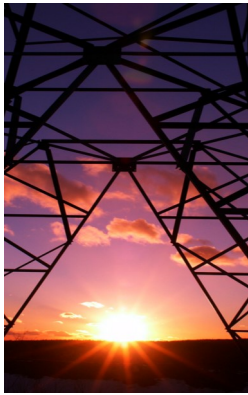

Nine new sermons were uploaded in Sept for **Russia** and also **Taiwan**.

Africa and also **Sri Lanka** programs were uploaded in October. **Sri Lanka** sermons are heard on Wednesdays; **Taiwan** sermons on Fridays, **Moscow** sermons on Thursdays. Africans have heard the Voice of Truth on Mondays for over a year, since Sep-

tember 2016. I continue to receive letters from Africans who take the time and expense to write. Whole churches are listening! Recently, an anonymous brother-in-Christ gave us 100 Bibles to give to Africans.

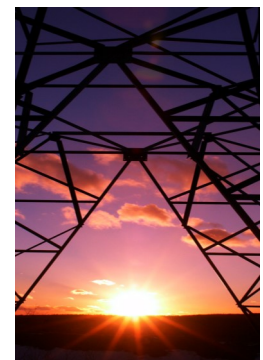


Iva Nell and Larry married in 1967 in Lawrenceburg, TN. They have been blessed to use their years preaching and teaching the gospel of Jesus Christ.

“A sower went forth to sow.”

Matthew 13:3

And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations.... (Matthew 24:14 ESV)

We preach because the millions need to hear the only means of their salvation. Gospel preaching itself is a **witness** to the world of the salvation of God through His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ. When sin and corruption engulf the world, God has always left a “witness” to the masses. He left Noah and his family as the only standing witnesses of God’s judgment (Genesis 9:9), and the rainbow as a “witness” of His mercy (Genesis 9:12-17). God had Moses to write a song as a “witness” because God did not want to be forgotten when people would go off into sin! (Deuteronomy 31:19-21) The old prophet Isaiah obeyed God, found a “tablet” and wrote down God’s eternal words, because God wanted them to be remembered forever! (Isaiah 30:8) Jesus said, “Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.” (Matthew 24:35) Amidst the sin and rebellion of our age this “witness” of “God’s word” to the nations must be preached! By Christ’s command it has fallen to the church of Christ to preach God’s word as a witness to the nations. (Matthew 28:18-20) This witness must stand before the world “in season and out of season”, whether they listen or do not listen! (2 Timothy 4:1-5)

We preach to the masses because local churches of Christ are established and strengthened by sowing the seed, preaching the Gospel. The Seed must fall upon the ears! The Kingdom of Christ grows when people hear and obey the gospel of Christ and are added by the Lord himself to his Church (Acts 2:37-47). Churches are established in locations where people have heard and obeyed the Gospel of their salvation (Acts 2:47; 1 Corinthians 12:13). Jesus commanded His people to “come together” or assemble (1 Corinthians 11:18, 20), to remember His suffering in body and the shedding of His blood (Matthew 26:26-28; 1 Corinthians 11:23-34, Hebrews 10:25). This special remembrance is called the Lord’s Supper (1 Corinthians 11:20). It’s observance makes sense because it was Jesus’ death (good news) that empowers God to forgive people! (Romans 1:16) And as often as assemblies of Christians eat the bread and drink the cup of the Lord Christians **show** His death to the watching world. The “supper” is a witness! The New Testament era Christians met on the first day of the week for this weekly remembrance. Their example sets an authentic precedence for Christians who seek to restore the ancient pattern in contemporary life (Acts 20:7; cf. 1 Corinthians 16:1, 2).

The Voice of Truth radio program is a 15-minute Gospel message that generally moves along five steps, the Attention Step, Need Step, Satisfaction Step, Visualization Step, and the Action Step. The Action Step is at the end of the program and can be personalized to contain your missionary's telephone number and the Voice of Truth website location. I almost always end my message by saying, "Visit a church of Christ near you where you can learn more about [the day's topic]...." Thus the hearer has opportunity to respond to the message and get more information about the church of Christ.

Your mission church or missionary can be featured in the Action Step of each broadcast. Location of the church building can be promoted; advertising a telephone number of a missionary has proven highly effective. Your own Website can also be advertised. You can arrange the radio time or we can arrange these for you; the Voice of Truth messages, both audio and scripts, are free. The broadcasts become a part of your church's outreach. It is like adding a gospel preacher to your staff for the cost of a time-slot on radio, typically less than \$80 per 15 minutes on the air. You can broadcast these messages by local radio or international shortwave.

Each broadcast teaches some aspect of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Preaching Christ is to preach the gospel plan of salvation. Preaching Christ is also to preach the church of Christ, Christ's kingdom. Preaching Christ is to speak of His Father who sent Jesus on the mission. Preaching Christ is to promote the Christian life taught by the Holy Spirit, lived every day by true Christians. Each 15-minute message is fashioned to attract and inform the lost by explaining the gospel of Christ.

The messages are spoken in English that learners of English-as-a-second-language can understand. The Bible is the text, most generally quoted from the English Standard Version. However, in many cases the more familiar King James readings are preferred. If you wish, your missionary can receive from us the English lesson scripts and record them in his own voice or language for local radio broadcast. The Voice of Truth audio and scripts are free, over 200 are available; 75 titles are available for download at our website. Contact Larry Murdock for additional titles. We pray that God will continue blessing all of His people in the ministry of preaching to the masses the pure Gospel of Jesus Christ via radio, television, and internet.
